

15 The Orange County District Attorney charges that in Orange  
16 County, California, the law was violated as follows:

17 COUNT 1: On or about February 22, 2014, in violation of Section  
18 273a(a) of the Penal Code (CHILD ENDANGERMENT BY CARETAKER), a  
19 MISDEMEANOR, ALEKSANDRA URBAN, under circumstances and  
20 conditions likely to produce great bodily harm and death, and  
21 having the care and custody of MINOR JANE DOE, a child, did  
22 willfully, unlawfully, and as a result of criminal negligence,  
23 cause and permit that child to be placed in a situation where  
24 the child's health was endangered.

25 COUNT 2: On or about February 22, 2014, in violation of Section  
26 23152(a) of the Vehicle Code (DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF  
27 ALCOHOL WITH ONE PRIOR), a MISDEMEANOR, ALEKSANDRA URBAN did  
28 unlawfully drive a vehicle while under the influence of an  
alcoholic beverage, and pursuant to Vehicle Code section 23540,  
the defendant, ALEKSANDRA URBAN, within ten (10) years of the  
commission of the above offense, committed a separate violation  
of Vehicle Code Section 23103 as specified in section 23103.5,  
Vehicle Code section 23152, and Vehicle Code section 23153, for  
which the defendant was convicted.

1 COUNT 3: On or about February 22, 2014, in violation of Section  
2 23152(b) of the Vehicle Code (DRIVING WITH BLOOD ALCOHOL .08% OR  
3 MORE WITH ONE PRIOR), a MISDEMEANOR, ALEKSANDRA URBAN did  
4 unlawfully drive a vehicle while defendant's blood alcohol  
5 concentration was 0.08 percent (%) or more by weight of alcohol  
6 in defendant's blood, and pursuant to Vehicle Code section  
7 23540, the defendant, ALEKSANDRA URBAN, within ten (10) years  
8 of the commission of the above offense, committed a separate  
9 violation of Vehicle Code Section 23103 as specified in section  
10 23103.5, Vehicle Code section 23152, and Vehicle Code section  
11 23153, for which the defendant was convicted.

9 COUNT 4: On or about February 22, 2014, in violation of Section  
10 836.6(b) of the Penal Code (ESCAPE FROM ARREST), a MISDEMEANOR,  
11 ALEKSANDRA URBAN, who was lawfully arrested by a peace officer,  
12 and who knew and reasonably should have known that he/she had  
13 been so arrested, did unlawfully escape and attempt to escape  
14 from that peace officer.

13 COUNT 5: On or about February 22, 2014, in violation of Section  
14 148(a)(1) of the Penal Code (RESIST AND OBSTRUCT OFFICER),  
15 MISDEMEANOR, ALEKSANDRA URBAN did willfully and unlawfully  
16 resist, delay, and obstruct OFFICER MCGOWEN, who was a peace  
17 officer discharging and attempting to discharge the duty of his/  
18 her office and employment.

18 COUNT 6: On or about February 22, 2014, in violation of Section  
19 12500(a) of the Vehicle Code (DRIVE MOTOR VEHICLE WITHOUT A  
20 VALID LICENSE), a MISDEMEANOR, ALEKSANDRA URBAN did unlawfully  
21 drive a motor vehicle upon a highway without then holding a  
22 valid driver's license issued under the Vehicle Code.

22 OTHER ALLEGATION(S)

23 As to Count(s) 2 and 3, it is further alleged pursuant to  
24 Section 23538(b)(2) of the Vehicle Code (BLOOD ALCOHOL .20  
25 PERCENT) that defendant ALEKSANDRA URBAN had a blood alcohol  
26 concentration of .20 percent and more, by weight.




