Since the U.S. District Court clerk does not complete the State Bar's Notice of Lack of Appeal form, the complete docket certified on October 3, 2014 is provided to demonstrate that no party has filed a notice of appeal within the statutory time period after the filing of the judgment on January 18, 2013. 
