This matter is before the court on Trezanay Michelle Atkins's July 28, 2016, motion for relief from paying disciplinary costs or extension of time to pay disciplinary costs. Atkins's motion contains a verified declaration regarding her current financial circumstances and attached to the motion is a financial declaration that she executed on July 22, 2016. The State Bar's Office of Chief Trial Counsel (OCTC) filed a partial opposition to Atkins's motion on August 17, 2016, in which it opposed Atkins's request for relief from paying disciplinary costs, but it did not oppose a request for an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs.

Upon review of Atkins's filings, she has established sufficient grounds of hardship, special circumstances, or other good cause, based on the loss of her two jobs and her other difficulties in supporting herself and her two children, to extend the time for payment of the costs. Accordingly, the court will extend the time to pay costs as set forth *post*.

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ORDERS

The court ORDERS that Trezanay Michelle Atkins's July 28, 2016, motion is GRANTED to the extent that time in which she must pay the assessed disciplinary costs is extended as set forth *post* and that, in all other respects, Atkins's July 28, 2016, motion is DENIED.

The court further ORDERS that the time in which Trezanay Michelle Atkins must pay the \$7,431.00 in disciplinary costs assessed against her under the Supreme Court's June 17, 2016 order in *In re Trezanay Michelle Atkins on Discipline*, case number S232835 (State Bar Court case number 14-J_05671) is EXTENDED as follows: Trezanay Michelle Atkins must pay \$100 no later than March 15, 2017, and then pay \$300 each year in 2018, 2019, and 2020, no later than March 15 in each respective year, with the remainder of disciplinary costs due no later than March 15, 2021. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6086.10, subd. (c); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B).)

The court further ORDERS that, if Trezanay Michelle Atkins fails to pay any installment of costs within the time described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, then the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


