**IN THE SUPREME COURT OF CALIFORNIA**

**En Banc**

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In re JENNY WONG on Discipline

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The court orders that the probation of Jenny Wong, State Bar Number 248111, is revoked. The court further orders that:

1. Jenny Wong is suspended from the practice of law for a minimum of one year, and she will remain suspended until the following requirements are satisfied:
  - i. She makes restitution to the following payees (or reimburses the Client Security Fund, to the extent of any payment from the fund to the payees, in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6140.5) and furnishes proof to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles:
    - (1) Soo Young Song in the amount of \$2,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from July 1, 2010;
    - (2) Won Kyung Park in the amount of \$2,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from July 1, 2010;
    - (3) Teresa Osuna in the amount of \$3,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from July 1, 2010;
  - ii. If she remains suspended for two years or more as a result of not satisfying the preceding condition, she must also provide proof to the State Bar Court of her rehabilitation, fitness to practice and learning and ability in the general law before her suspension will be terminated. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, tit. IV, Stds. for Atty. Sanctions for Prof. Misconduct, std. 1.4(c)(ii).)

**EXHIBIT**

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- Jenny Wong is given credit towards the one year suspension for the period of involuntary inactive enrollment which commenced on September 6, 2013.


Jenny Wong must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


