On January 19, 2016, Respondent filed a motion seeking relief from the order assessing costs in the above matters. The amount of the remaining costs is stated to be \$19,890.79. Respondent asks this court for relief from having to pay these costs and/or to extend the time for him to do so. In support of his motion, Respondent provided a financial statement showing his financial inability to pay the required costs.

On February 18, 2016, the State Bar filed a response to the motion, not objecting to a limited reduction of the amount of costs or an extension of time for Respondent to pay them, but objecting to any complete relief from having to pay any costs.

GOOD CAUSE having been shown, Respondent's obligation to pay costs is hereby modified and extended as follows:

The amount of costs is reduced to \$15,000. These costs will be due and payable in five installments as follows:

- The first installment, in the amount of \$1,000, will be due on February 1, 2017;
- The second installment, in the amount of \$2,000, will be due on February 1, 2018;
- The third installment, in the amount of \$3,000, will be due on February 1, 2019;
- The fourth installment, in the amount of \$4,000, will be due on February 1, 2020; and
- The fifth installment, in the amount of \$5,000, will be due on February 1, 2021.

If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar or the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs will be due immediately and be enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
