On February 7, 2017, Respondent filed a motion seeking relief from the order assessing costs in the above matters.¹ In prior orders, this court had first allowed those costs to be paid in two separate installments and, in a subsequent order, had agreed to delay the due date for the first installment. As a result, all of the costs are now coming due. Respondent asks this court to extend the time for her to pay those costs. In support of her motion, she provided a financial statement showing her present financial inability to pay the required costs.

On February 10, 2017, the State Bar filed an opposition to any reduction of the amount of the cost obligation but a statement of non-opposition to an extension of the time for Respondent to pay those costs.

GOOD CAUSE having been shown, Respondent's obligation to pay costs is hereby modified and extended as follows: the sum of the disciplinary costs currently still owed (Present Balance) will be due and payable in three installments, with one-third of the Present Balance to be paid by Respondent on or before each of the deadlines for payment of membership fees for the years 2018, 2019, and 2020. If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar or the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs will be due immediately and be enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


