On September 16, 2016, respondent Nathaniel Jay Friedman (Respondent) filed a motion requesting a one-year extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). Respondent, who is currently experiencing serious health problems, took the MPRE on two occasions, but has yet to achieve a passing score. He plans to take the November 2016 MPRE. On September 22, 2016, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade filed a response to the motion for extension. The Office of Probation opposes a one-year extension, but does not oppose an extension of time to allow Respondent to take the November 2016 MPRE.

After thorough consideration, the court finds granting an extension of time to take and pass the November 2016 MPRE is consistent with protecting the public; the member's successful rehabilitation; and maintaining the integrity of the legal profession. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.300(B).) Accordingly, Respondent's motion for extension is **GRANTED**, however, this



extension is limited to the November 2016 MPRE.¹ Respondent is **ORDERED** to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before December 29, 2016.²

IT IS SO ORDERED.
