By motion filed October 4, 2017, **ALBERT MIKLOS KUN** (Respondent), sought relief from, or extension of time to comply with the order assessing disciplinary costs in State Bar Court case no. 14-O--05418. Respondent's motion was based on financial hardship. On October 19, 2017, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar), filed a response to Respondent's motion. The State Bar opposed Respondent's request for relief from disciplinary costs but the State Bar did not oppose Respondent's request to extend the time to pay the disciplinary costs.

After reviewing the parties' pleadings, the court issues the following orders:

1. Respondent's request for an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs is **GRANTED** in view of Respondent's financial hardship and for good cause shown. The court orders that Respondent's payment of disciplinary costs be extended by three years to be paid in three installments with Respondent's annual State Bar membership fees for the years 2019, 2020 and 2021.
2. The court further orders that if Respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under rule 5.134. Payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
