10 2. On or about August 24, 2013, Respondent agreed to attempt to negotiate a mortgage  
11 loan modification or other mortgage loan forbearance for a fee for a client, Lucy Pastran, and  
12 thereafter between August 26, 2013 and February 28, 2014 Respondent received \$4,975 from the  
13 client before Respondent had fully performed each and every service Respondent had been  
14 contracted to perform or represented to the client that Respondent would perform, in violation of  
15 Civil Code, section 2944.7, and in willful violation of Business and Professions Code, section  
16 6106.3.


