
However, it is the policy of the court to favor, whenever possible, disposition on the merits. (*In the Matter of Navarro* (Review Dept. 1990) 1 Cal. State Bar Ct. Rptr. 192, 198.) It appears to the court that respondent's failure to file a response was a result of respondent's mistake, inadvertence, surprise, or excusable neglect, within the meaning of Code of Civil Procedure section 473(b). (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.83(C).)

Therefore, having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the court **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The motion to set aside respondent's default entered on December 15, 2015, is hereby **GRANTED**;
2. Respondent's inactive enrollment, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (e), is **TERMINATED**, effective as of the date of this order;
3. Respondent's proposed answer to the NDC, filed with the motion, is deemed filed and served as of the date this order is filed;
4. Respondent must cooperate with the State Bar in its discovery (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.65); and
5. The parties must appear at a telephonic status conference set for **January 19, 2016**, at **9:30 a.m.**

IT IS SO ORDERED.
