This matter is before the court on Holly S. Burgess's May 25, 2017, motion for an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs and to reimburse the Client Security Fund (CSF). On June 5, 2017, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed an opposition to Burgess's motion.

Burgess has established sufficient hardship and other good cause to extend the time in which she must pay the \$3,497 in disciplinary costs assessed against her in this proceeding. The court, however, lacks jurisdiction to extend the time in which Burgess must reimburse CSF.

**ORDER**

The court orders that Holly S. Burgess's May 25, 2017, motion is GRANTED to the extent that the court will extend the time to pay disciplinary costs, but the motion is DISMISSED for want of jurisdiction to the extent that it seeks an extension of time to reimburse CSF. The time in which Holly S. Burgess must pay the disciplinary costs imposed on her under the Supreme Court's September 23, 2015, order in *In re Holly S. Burgess on Discipline*, case number S227716 (State Bar Court case number 14-O-02467) is EXTENDED as follows: Holly S.



Burgess must pay one-third of the costs no later than February 1 for each of the years 2019, 2020, and 2021. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6086.10, subd. (c); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B).) If Holly S. Burgess fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court under Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c) and the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar, the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134.) Until they are paid in full, the costs remain enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


