ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION RE MODIFICATION OF PROBATION CONDITION

## TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE-ENTITLED MATTER:

On July 12, 2016, respondent Douglas Randall Ensminger, represented by attorney John P. Salisbury, and Senior Trial Counsel Esther J. Rogers of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed a stipulation for modification of terms of probation. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.301.) The parties stipulated that respondent's probation be extended from July 13, 2016, to October 13, 2016, to allow respondent time to take the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) on August 13, 2016.

The court finds that the stipulation to be fair to the parties and that it adequately protects the public. Accordingly, the stipulation for modification of terms of probation is **APPROVED**. It is **ORDERED** that respondent's probationary period is extended until October 13, 2016, and respondent must provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before October 13, 2016. IT IS SO ORDERED.
