On May 30, 2017, respondent Julius Michael Engel filed a motion for relief from or extension of time to pay disciplinary costs imposed by the February 15, 2017 Supreme Court order, case No. S238645, based on his financial hardship.

On June 1, 2017, Senior Trial Counsel Erica L. M. Dennings of the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar opposed respondent's motion.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, respondent's request for relief from disciplinary costs is granted, in part, in that respondent's time during which to pay the disciplinary costs in S238645 is extended and that one-half of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2018 and 2019. If Julius Michael Engel fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
