



In re BRENDA LYNN McCUNE on Discipline

The court orders that Brenda Lynn McCune, State Bar Number 186945, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that her name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

Brenda Lynn McCune must make restitution to the following payees:

- (1) Elvia Espinoza in the amount of \$2,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from June 17, 2013; and
- (2) James Krueger in the amount of \$5,000 plus 10 percent interest per year from November 21, 2013.

Any restitution owed to the Client Security Fund is enforceable as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.5, subdivisions (c) and (d).

Brenda Lynn McCune must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


