
On March 20, 2015, Respondent filed a motion seeking relief from the orders assessing costs in the above matters. More specifically, Respondent asks that this court reduce and/or create an installment plan for payments of the costs currently owed by her. In support of her motion, Respondent provided a financial statement showing her present limited financial ability to pay the required costs.

On April 2, 2015, the State Bar notified the court of its opposition to the request that the costs be reduced but its non-opposition to the motion seeking an installment plan.

GOOD CAUSE having been shown, the motion seeking an installment plan is granted. Rather than require monthly payments, the court orders a three-year installment plan, with one-third of the currently outstanding costs to be paid by Respondent with his membership fees for each of the years 2016, 2017, and 2018. If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar or the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs is due immediately and is enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


