Since respondent Tony Kevin Smith, State Bar Number 210512, has been convicted of violating Vehicle Code section 23153, subdivisions (a) (driving under the influence and causing injury) and (b) (driving under the influence with blood alcohol content of .08% or more and causing injury) with enhancements for blood alcohol content of .15% or higher under section 23578, felonies which may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective October 13, 2015, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the judgment of conviction is final, this case is referred to the Hearing Department for a hearing and decision as to whether the facts and circumstances surrounding the violations of which respondent was convicted involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline, and if so found, the discipline to be imposed.


