Since respondent Edward Joseph Callow, State Bar Number 228834, has been convicted of violating Revised Code of Washington sections 9A.28.040, 9A.56.030, subdivision (1)(a) (conspiracy to commit theft in the first degree), 9A.56.030, subdivision (1)(a) (theft in the first degree), 9A.83.020, subdivision (1)(b) (money laundering), and 9A.60.030 (obtaining a signature by deception or duress), felonies involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective July 5, 2016, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

On May 13, 2016, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar filed a motion for summary disbarment based on respondent's felony conviction. This court will file separately its recommendation on that motion.
