Since respondent Tina Lavonne James, State Bar Number 174628, has been convicted of violating Welfare and Institutions Code section 10980, subdivision (c)(2) (aid by misrepresentation-over \$400), a felony involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective June 20, 2016, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

On May 6, 2016, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar filed a motion for summary disbarment based on respondent's felony conviction. This court will file separately its recommendation on that motion.
