Crime(s) of which convicted and classification(s): Violation of Title 18 United States Code §1512(k) (Conspiracy to Obstruct Justice), a felony involving moral turpitude; Title 18 United States Code §1512(c)(2) (Obstruction of Justice – corruptly obstructs, influences, or impedes any official proceeding), a felony involving moral turpitude as in *Miss. Bar v Delaughter* 38 So. 3d 631; and Title 18 United States Code §1512(b)(3) (Obstruction of Justice - corruptly persuades another person with intent to hinder, delay, or prevent the communication to a law enforcement officer or judge of the United States of information relating to the commission or possible commission of a federal offense or a violation of conditions of release pending judicial proceedings), a felony involving moral turpitude as in *In re Blair* 40 A.3d 883.

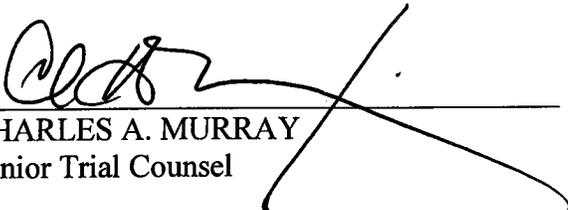
