Crime(s) of which convicted and classification(s): Violation of California Penal Code § 422 (Make Threats Which Would Result in Great Bodily Injury or Death), one count, a misdemeanor which may or may not involve moral turpitude; California Penal Code § 136.1(b)(1) (Prevent or Dissuade a Witness or Victim), one count, a misdemeanor a crime involving moral turpitude as it involves witness tampering/obstruction of justice (People v. McGee (1914, Cal App) 24 Cal App 563 [the common-law offense of obstructing justice is described in this section]; (In re Craig (1938) 12 Cal.2d 93, 97 ["no doubt that the offense of conspiring to corruptly influence, obstruct, impede, hinder and embarrass the due administration of justice . . . falls easily within the definition of 'moral turpitude.'"]); California Penal Code § 415 (3) (Use of Offensive Words in a Public Place), one count, a misdemeanor which may or may not involve moral turpitude.


