Since respondent Stephen Young Kang, State Bar Number 196165, was convicted of violating title 18 United States Code section 1343 (wire fraud), a felony involving moral turpitude, and title 26 United States Code section 7201 (tax evasion), a felony that provides probable cause to believe it involves moral turpitude based on record of conviction, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective March 14, 2016, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.


