Respondent, Sheen Myong Na, responds to the notice of disciplinary charges filed herein as follows:

2. Respondent specifically denies each of the allegations and charges contained in Count One, Paragraph (2) (A), (B), (C) of the notice of disciplinary charges as follows, except that Respondent specifically admits the following:

(A) Respondent had trouble to receive the notice by mail in time, and could not attend.

But it was done afterward over the telephone communication.



1 (B) Respondent reported but the report was incorrectly format, and refiled immediately
2 after correction.

3 (C) Respondent took the MPRE test, and reported the test score 54 but it was
4 insufficient score to pass California's minimum score to pass that was 87. Thereafter,
5 respondent retook three more tests. All the scores from the three tests, in August, 2014,
6 November 2014, March 2015, scores in the same order, 67, 67, 74 failed to pass 87 California
7 minimum score to pass. Respondent took those test after he filed motion to extend to pass the
8 test. Even though, he registered to take August, and November, 2015 tests, he gave them up,
9 because it was certain he would fail again.
10

11 EXTENUATING AND MITIGATING CIRCUMSTANCE

12 Respondent filed three motions to extend the deadline to pass MPRE primarily based on
13 his health problem such as diabetic. Respondent explained that his health condition affected his
14 reading speed, which was only 100-120 words/minute. The low speed hampered completion of
15 his test. He reported that he always had 10-15 questions left out unfinished.
16

17 In 2015, respondent registered two tests in August, and November. But he did not take
18 those two tests because he knew he could not pass those tests.
19

20 In late August, 2015, respondent found that his problem is not diabetics but he had
21 ADHD (Attention Deficit and Hyperactive Disorder) symptoms for life. ADHD is one of the
22 medical symptoms allowed for accommodation in MPRE rest because those afflicted by it
23 cannot or leave out many things to understand when reading of any writings is involved.
24 Respondent found it was too late to get the ADHD test results because it normally takes a
25 couple of months to complete after 10 hours tests by 3 or 4 sessions with a licensed
26 psychologist tests. The request for accommodation must be done in advance with sufficient


1 time if reconsideration request is necessary.

2 Respondent has arranged ADHD tests with a licensed psychologist in April, 2016, and
3 the test result will be out in the middle of May, 2016. After the results come, respondent will
4 apply for accommodation by NCBE/PRE for August, 2016 test.

5 Respondent is confident that first, his request for accommodation will be granted,
6 secondly, he will pass the MPRE test when the requested accommodation for extended time to
7 complete the test.

9 WHEREFORE, respondent prays that the Hearing Panel find that the acts charged did
10 not constitute profession misconduct because it was caused by respondent's physical condition
11 that was unknown to respondent, or if misconduct is found, that it be excused by virtue of the
12 mitigating circumstances submitted.


