The State Bar of California alleges:

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JURISDICTION

1. CORECIA JOY WOO ("respondent") was admitted to the practice of law in the State of California on September 4, 2001, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is currently a member of the State Bar of California.

COUNT ONE

Case No. 15-O-12351
Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k)
[Failure to Comply with Conditions of Probation]

2. Respondent failed to comply with conditions attached to respondent's disciplinary probation in State Bar Case No. 08-O-10238, et al., as follows, in willful violation of Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k):

- A. Failing to submit a quarterly report by its due date of October 10, 2013;
- B. Failing to comply with Business and Professions Code section 6068(a) of the State Bar Act by sustaining a conviction on or about October 2, 2013, for violating California Vehicle Code section 23152(b); and
- C. Failing to report the conviction for violating California Vehicle Code section 23152(b) that respondent sustained on or about October 2, 2013, to the Office of Probation on the quarterly report due by January 10, 2014.

COUNT TWO

Case No. 15-O-12351
Business and Professions Code, section 6106
[Moral Turpitude - Misrepresentation]

3. From on or about October 10, 2013, through on or about April 7, 2014, respondent falsely reported under the penalty of perjury on her quarterly reports submitted to the Office of Probation on or about October 10, 2013, January 8, 2014 and April 7, 2014, that "[d]uring the reporting period noted above, I have complied with all provisions of the State Bar Act, Rules of Professional Conduct, and all conditions of probation; and during the preceding calendar quarter, there were no proceedings pending against me in the State Bar Court, or if there were, I have attached my declaration, signed under penalty of perjury, regarding my pending proceeding(s) in

1 State Bar Court including the case number(s), and current status” when respondent knew or was
2 grossly negligent in not knowing the statement(s) were false, and thereby committed an act
3 involving moral turpitude, dishonesty or corruption in willful violation of Business and
4 Professions Code, section 6106.


