By motion filed January 16, 2019, **DELIA METOYER** (Respondent), sought relief from payment of costs or in the alternative, an extension of time to comply with the order assessing the disciplinary costs in the above-captioned State Bar Court matter (Motion). (Rules Proc. Of State Bar, rule 5.130(B)) Respondent's motion was based on financial hardship. On January 29, 2019, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (OCTC) filed a response opposing relief from, but not an extension of time to pay the assessed costs.

After reviewing the parties' pleadings, the court issues the following orders:

- 1. Respondent's motion for complete relief from payment of disciplinary costs is **DENIED**, no good cause having been shown; and
- 2. Respondent is **GRANTED** an extension of time to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs. The court orders that Respondent's time to commence payment of disciplinary costs associated with the above-referenced matter be extended and shall be paid with Respondent's annual State Bar membership fees for the years 2020, 2021 and 2022.
- 3. The court further orders that, if Respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and



Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules Proc. Of State Bar, rule 5.134. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
