The court orders that Timothy Brooks Balcom, State Bar Number 190496, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

Timothy Brooks Balcom must make restitution to the following payees:

- (1) Justin Long in the amount of \$2,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from November 12, 2014;
- (2) Evelyn and Ted Apostolou in the amount of \$2,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from December 26, 2014;
- (3) Earl and Sonia Sinclair in the amount of \$2,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 5, 2015; and
- (4) Erica Fontenot in the amount of \$1,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 5, 2015.

Any restitution owed to the Client Security Fund is enforceable as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.5, subdivisions (c) and (d).

Timothy Brooks Balcom must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


