17 **RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF**  
18 **DISCIPLINARY CHARGES**

19 **COMES NOW RESPONDENT JEFFREY T. BOLSON, ESQ. , *in propria persona,***  
20 **and Answering the Charges against him, admits, denies and alleges as follows:**

21 **JURISDICTION**

22 1. Respondent admits the allegations of paragraph 1.

23 **COUNT ONE**

24 2. Respondent admits that he failed to keep certain agreements made in lieu of  
25 disciplinary prosecution in State Bar Case no. 14-O-2015, and denies other allegation as follows:  
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1           4. Respondent quickly and freely admitted his mistake with respect to Count Two, and  
2 forthwith fulfilled his MCLE requirements, as he has done since the MCLE requirements were  
3 instituted.

5           5. At the of the date of the MCLE response, Respondent had dissolved a law firm and  
6 established a new law firm (sole practice), with different computerized back up. At the time  
7 reporting was due, respondent represented his compliance to the best of his knowledge and, in  
8 fact, sought confirmation from his former office manager (and wife), that he had complied.

10           6. Respondent maintains a law office designation, but ceased representing clients through  
11 his own office, instead being associated and/or "of counsel" to other firms. As such, Respondent  
12 does not employ any clerical or other assistance, and while Respondent does not deny receipt  
13 of the Probation forms in or before January of 2015, neither does Respondent have any record or  
14 recollection of receipt. Moreover, if indeed there was any attempt to contact Respondent at his  
15 email address on file with the State Bar, Respondent no longer utilized nor reviewed that email  
16 account since he no longer practiced law under his own "law office." Respondent admits that he  
17 should have updated his State Bar Profile on line.

20           7. Respondent is aware of at least one circumstance in which the Office of Probation of  
21 the State Bar of California mis-addressed correspondence to him.


23           8. Respondent has engaged in lengthy discussions with the Office of the Chief Trial  
24 Counsel with respect to confidential mitigating factors, and has submitted to the Office of Trial  
25 Counsel those mitigating factors, and understands that a settlement has been agreed to in  
26 principle.  
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Based on the foregoing, Respondent requests the charges against him be dismissed.


