2 JURISDICTION

3 1. Jeffrey Thomas Bolson ("Respondent") was admitted to the practice of law in the  
4 State of California on December 1, 1981, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges,  
5 and is currently a member of the State Bar of California.

6 COUNT ONE

7 Case No. 15-O-13696  
8 Business and Professions Code section 6068(l)  
[Failure to Comply with Agreement in Lieu of Discipline]

9 2. Respondent failed to keep all agreements made in lieu of disciplinary prosecution  
10 with the agency charged with attorney discipline in State Bar case no. 14-O-01613, as follows, in  
11 willful violation of Business and Professions Code section 6068(l):

- 12 A. Failing to contact the Office of Probation by January 16, 2015 to schedule a
- 13 meeting with the assigned Probation Officer;
- 14 B. Failing to meet with his assigned Probation Deputy; and
- 15 C. Failing to timely submit three quarterly reports by their due dates of January
- 16 10, 2015, April 10, 2015, and October 10, 2015.

17 COUNT TWO

19 Business and Professions Code section 6106  
20 [Moral Turpitude – Misrepresentation of MCLE Compliance]

21 3. On or about June 11, 2013, Respondent falsely reported under the penalty of  
22 perjury to the State Bar that Respondent had fully complied with Respondent's minimum  
23 continuing legal education ("MCLE") requirements for the period of February 1, 2010 to January  
24 31, 2013, when Respondent knew or was grossly negligent in not knowing that Respondent had  
25 failed to complete the MCLE requirements for that period, and thereby committed an act  
26 involving moral turpitude, dishonesty or corruption in willful violation of Business and  
27 Professions Code, section 6106.


