

This matter is before the court on Emory Luther King, Jr.'s May 30, 2017, motion for relief from or extension of time to pay costs. The Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California filed an opposition to King's motion on June 9, 2017.

King has failed to establish sufficient hardship, special circumstances, or other good cause to grant him relief from any of the disciplinary costs assessed against him in this proceeding. King, however, has established sufficient hardship, special circumstances, and other good cause to extend the time in which he must pay the disciplinary costs assessed against him.

**ORDER**

The court orders that Emory Luther King, Jr.'s May 30, 2017, motion is GRANTED to the extent that the court will extend the time to pay disciplinary costs, but the motion is DENIED to the extent that it seeks relief from all or part of those costs. The time in which Emory Luther King, Jr. must pay the disciplinary costs imposed on him under the Supreme Court's January 5, 2017, order in *In re Emory Luther King, Jr. on Discipline*, case number S238160 (State Bar Court case number 15-O-13778) is EXTENDED as follows: One-fifth of the costs must be paid



with Emory Luther King, Jr.'s annual State Bar membership fee for each of the years 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6086.10, subd. (c); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B).) If Emory Luther King, Jr. fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court under Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c) and the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar, the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.134.) Until they are paid in full, the costs remain enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
