On April 19, 2016, Kenneth L. Gross ("Respondent"), by and through his counsel, Marissa Buck Esq., and Allison Rhodes, Esq., filed a Motion To Modify The Terms of Probation, seeking to modify his probation terms to extend the time for him to provide proof of passage of the State Bar's Ethics School and proof of passage of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination ("MPRE"). Respondent seeks this modification due to medical reasons. On April 29, 2016, the Office of Probation for the State Bar of California, by Supervising Attorney, Terrie Goldade, Esq., filed a non-opposition in response to Respondent's motion.

Upon consideration of the pleadings and for GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, this court **GRANTS** Respondent's motion for modification of these conditions of his probation, *nunc pro tunc*. This court further orders Respondent to provide the Office of Probation for the State Bar of California, proof of completion of passage of the State Bar Ethics School and the MPRE, by December 31, 2016.
