On September 26, 2016, the State Bar filed a motion to modify the stipulation of the parties, lodged on April 7, 2016 (and modified and filed by this court on April 18, 2016), to delete the probation condition requiring Respondent to comply with the terms of a criminal probation. The motion states that this condition was mistakenly included in the stipulation and that there is no such criminal probation. The motion further indicates that Respondent is aware of the requested modification and has no objection to it.


The subject stipulation has now become the basis for both an order of this court and an order of the Supreme Court. Rather than treating this motion solely as one seeking only to modify the terms of the stipulation, this court will also treat the motion as also seeking to modify the conditions of Respondent's probation, now ordered by the Supreme Court. (See Calif. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(c)(2); Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.301.)

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, the court hereby modifies the stipulation and the accompanying order by this court filed on April 18, 2016, and deletes, *nunc pro tunc*, the above condition of probation.
