On April 17, 2017, the Supreme Court issued an order in the captioned matter, disciplining Respondent and ordering her to pay costs. This order imposing costs, however, allowed Respondent to pay costs in installments, with one-third of the costs to be paid with Respondent's membership fees for each of the years 2018, 2019, and 2020.

On September 17, 2018, Respondent filed a motion requesting an extension to February 1, 2019, of the time for her to pay the first installment of her cost obligation.

On October 12, 2018, the State Bar filed a statement of opposition to the request.

GOOD CAUSE having been shown, Respondent's obligation to pay costs is hereby modified and extended as follows: the sum of the disciplinary costs currently still owed will be paid in three equal installments, with one-third of that remaining balance to be paid by Respondent on or before February 1, 2019; and the remaining two installments to be paid on or before each of the deadlines for payment of membership fees for the years 2019 and 2020, respectively. If Respondent fails to pay any of the above installment payments more than 10 days after its due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar or the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs will be due immediately and be enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


