In the Matter of: MICHAEL ROSS LEWIS A Member of the State Bar, No. 247934	Case No(s): 15-O-14877-YDR ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO PAY DISCIPLINARY COSTS

By motion filed October 6, 2017, MICHAEL ROSS LEWIS (Respondent), sought a one year extension of time to comply with the order assessing disciplinary costs in the above-captioned matter. (Rules Proc. Of State Bar, rule 5.130(B)) Respondent's motion was based on financial hardship. On October 30, 2017, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar) filed a response. The State Bar did not oppose the one year extension of time to pay costs.

Good cause having been shown, Respondent's motion for extension of time to comply with the order to pay disciplinary costs is **GRANTED**. The court orders that Respondent's time to commence payment of disciplinary costs associated with case no. 15-O-14877 be extended and that Respondent's outstanding costs shall be paid in three installments with Respondent's annual State Bar membership fees for the years 2018, 2019 and 2020.

The court further orders that, if Respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules Proc. Of State Bar, rule 5.134. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


