On August 25, 2017, the Supreme Court issued an order placing respondent Arturo Reyes, Jr., on probation for one year and suspending him for the first 30 days of probation. Respondent was required to pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) and comply with rule 9.20 of the California Rules of Court. The order specified that respondent's stayed suspension would be satisfied at the conclusion of probation if he had complied with all conditions of probation.

On October 11, 2018, respondent filed a request to extend time to comply with rule 9.20 of the California Rules of Court, so that he may take the MPRE and continue his representation in his active client matters. The Office of Probation of the State Bar filed an opposition to the request on October 3, 2018.

Respondent has failed to show good cause in support of his request for an extension of time to take and pass the MPRE pursuant to rule 5.162(E) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar. Respondent's motion is therefore denied without prejudice to filing an amended motion



which demonstrates good cause pursuant to rule 5.162(E) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.
