Gentlepersons:

I, JAMES V. SARRO, SBN 54491, against whom charges are pending, hereby resign as a member of the State Bar of California and relinquish all right to practice law in the State of California. I agree that, in the event that this resignation is accepted and I later file a petition for reinstatement, the State Bar will consider in connection therewith all disciplinary matters and proceedings against me at the time this resignation is accepted, in addition to other appropriate matters. I also agree that the Supreme Court may decline to accept my resignation unless I reach agreement with the Chief Trial Counsel on a written stipulation as to facts and conclusions of law regarding the disciplinary matters and proceedings that were pending against me at the time of my resignation. I further agree that, on the filing of this resignation by the Office of the Clerk, State



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Bar Court, I will be transferred to inactive membership of the State Bar. On such transfer, I acknowledge that I will be ineligible to practice law or to advertise or hold myself out as practicing or as entitled to practice law. I further acknowledge that in the event the Supreme Court does not accept my resignation, I will remain an inactive member of the State Bar, pending any further order of the State Bar Court or Supreme Court. I further agree that, within 30 days of the filing of the resignation by the Office of the Clerk, State Bar Court, I will perform the acts specified in rule 9.20(a)-(b) of the California Rules of Court, and within 40 days of the date of filing of this resignation by the Office of the Clerk, State Bar Court, I will notify that office as specified in rule 9.20(c) of the California Rules of Court. If, but only if, required by current Rules of Court or other rules of the State Bar, I hereby waive the confidentiality of any disciplinary complaints, investigations or Client Security Fund matters pending against me.

For the record, I continue to contend that my errors in reporting compliance with MCLE were exactly that: errors. My failure was to not know and fully understand the rules regarding exactly how to remain in MCLE compliance, keep the necessary records and be able to prove compliance. When I reported my compliance, I honestly believed it to be true.
