On June 24, 2016, the Court dismissed the remaining charges: Vehicle Code §23152(a) (Driving under the Influence - Alcohol), a misdemeanor; Vehicle Code §20002(a) (Hit and Run – Property Damage), a misdemeanor; Vehicle Code §14601.1(a) (Driving while Privilege was Suspended/Revoked), a misdemeanor; and Vehicle Code §12500(a) (Driving without a Valid License), a misdemeanor.


