ORDER

On February 8, 2018, the court ordered respondent suspended from the practice of law effective March 12, 2018, pending final disposition of this proceeding, because he had been convicted of violating Penal Code section 32 (accessory to the unauthorized practice of law), a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. Our February 8 order acknowledged that a previous order filed November 1, 2017, had taken no action and stated that a violation of Business and Professions Code section 6126, subdivision (b), is a crime that may or may not involve moral turpitude. Our February 8 order clarified that respondent was convicted of Penal Code section 32, not Business and Professions Code section 6126, subdivision (b). On February 23, 2018, respondent's counsel filed a motion to delay the effective date of suspension. On March 7, 2018, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar (OCTC) filed an opposition to respondent's motion.

Good cause shown, we grant respondent's motion and extend the effective date of his



suspension for 30 days until April 11, 2018. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.162(D).)
