S229881, in willful violation of 12 California Rules of Court, rule 9.20. (A true and correct copy of the rule 9.20 order is attached 13 hereto as Exhibit 1 and is incorporated by reference.) 14 **COUNT TWO** 15 Case No. 16-O-15084 Business and Professions Code, section 6068(k) 16 [Failure to Comply with Conditions of Probation] 17 3. Respondent failed to comply with conditions attached to Respondent's disciplinary 18 probation in State Bar Case no. 10-C-08329 as follows, in willful violation of Business and 19 Professions Code, section 6068(k): 20 A. Failing to submit a quarterly report by its due date of July 10, 2016; 21 B. Failing to contact the Office of Probation to schedule a meeting within 30 days from 22 the effective date of the discipline; 23 C. Failing to submit a medical waiver by its due date of April 24, 2016; 24 D. Failing to submit lab reports by their due dates of April 10, May 10, June 10 and July 25 10, 2016; and 26 E. Failing to submit proof of attendance at an Abstinence Program Meeting by its due 27 date of July 10, 2016. 28
