**RESPONDENT'S WRITTEN RESPONSE TO DISCIPLINARY CHARGES AND
REQUEST FOR TRANSFER TO THE ALTERNATIVE DISCIPLINE PROGRAM (ADP)**

Pursuant to Rules of Proc. of State Bar, Rule 345(B), I, Respondent Adam J. Luetto, do hereby make the following written response to the, above referenced Disciplinary Charges, filed by the State Bar of California Office of Chief Counsel (the "State Bar"), on March 29, 2016:

I make no denial of the allegation contained in Count One of the State Bar's Notice of Disciplinary Charges, that I failed to comply with the September 25, 2015 Order (the "Order") of the Review Department of the State Bar Court ("State Bar Court") in Case Nos. 15-C-10306, 15-C-10307, 15-C-10308, and 15-C-13690, requiring me to file a declaration of compliance with California Rules of Court, Rule 9.20 in conformity with the requirements of rule 9.20(c) with the Clerk of the State Bar Court by November 4, 2015, in willful violation of Business and Professions Code section 6103.

Given that I was incarcerated on the date of November 4, 2015, and had been so, since on or about October 10, 2015, I had not received notice of the State Bar Court's Order as of the date upon which I was required to file the rule 9.20 Declaration. After I was released from the Los Angeles County Jail, in first week of December 2016, I obtained notice of the Order and as soon as I was capable attempt to file and did successfully file the requisite rule 9.20 declaration, in a good faith effort to cure my failure to timely comply with the Order.

Furthermore, in light of the fact that the underlying cases giving rise to the State Bar Court's Order have been consolidated and are currently under review for referral to the Alternative Discipline Program, I hereby request that this above referenced matter also be referred to the Alternative Discipline Program (ADP).
