ORDER

Since respondent Justin Jae Kim, State Bar Number 237501, has been convicted of violating: (1) Penal Code section 273.5, subdivision (a) (domestic battery with corporal injury), a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude; (2) Penal Code section 245, subdivision (a)(4) (assault with force likely to produce great bodily injury), a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude; (3) Penal Code section 245, subdivision (a)(1) (assault with a deadly weapon), a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude; (4) Penal Code section 594, subdivision (a)/(b)(2)(A) (vandalism under \$400), a misdemeanor which may or may not involve moral turpitude; (5) Penal Code section 243, subdivision (e)(1) (domestic violence battery), a misdemeanor which may or may not involve moral turpitude; and (6) two counts under Penal Code section 422, subdivision (a) (criminal threats), a misdemeanor which may or may not involve moral turpitude; it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective October 2, 2017, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in



subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the judgment of conviction is final, this case is referred to the hearing department for a hearing and decision as to whether the facts and circumstances surrounding the violations of which respondent was convicted involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline, and if so found, the discipline to be imposed.
