Since respondent Sean James Ballard, State Bar Number 160070, has been convicted of 17 counts of violating Penal Code section 186.10, subdivision (a) (money laundering), and one count of violating Penal Code section 487, subdivision (a) (grand theft), felonies involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective June 4, 2018, pending final disposition of this proceeding. Within 120 days of the date of this order, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar is ordered to submit evidence of finality or provide an update on finality.
