On February 21, 2017, counsel for Richard A. Schulenberg (Respondent) filed a motion for order permanently enrolling member as inactive or order to show cause pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 6007(b)(1). Respondent's motion is supported by letters from Respondent's treating physicians, Dr. Chow and Dr. Silverman, who both state that Respondent has experienced a decline in his cognitive abilities and is suffering from Alzheimer's disease. The Office of Chief Trial Counsel (OCTC), through Senior Trial Counsel Eli Morgenstern, filed a response stating that OCTC does not oppose Respondent's motion. Respondent's counsel, Robert Ross, Esq., filed a supplemental declaration in support of Respondent's motion.

For good cause shown, this court finds that there is clear and convincing evidence that involuntary inactive enrollment is warranted under Business and Professions Code section 6007, subdivision (b)(1). Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, effective three days after service of this order, Respondent Richard A. Schulenberg be involuntarily enrolled as an inactive member of the State Bar of California.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
