Since respondent Zachary Brooke Roberts, State Bar Number 201739, has been convicted of violating 18 United States Code section 371 (conspiracy to commit wire fraud), a felony involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective January 8, 2019, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

On November 7, 2018, we received evidence that the conviction is final and a request for summary disbarment from the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar (OCTC). Our recommendation on OCTC's request for summary disbarment will issue separately.


