On June 14, 2019, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar (OCTC) filed a Transmittal of Records of Conviction that respondent Michael Lawrence Connell, State Bar Number 164648, has been convicted of violating title 18 United States Code section 2252, subdivision (a)(4)(B) (possession of child pornography), a felony that involves moral turpitude. Respondent did not file a response. It is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective August 5, 2019, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

Within 120 days of the date of this order, the Office of Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar is ordered to submit evidence of finality or provide an update on finality.
