On April 13, 2010, Leon Jacob Atlas filed a motion seeking relief in full from disciplinary costs as to the captioned matters due to financial hardship.<sup>1</sup> On May 11, 2010, the State Bar, by Deputy Trial Counsel Mark Hartman, filed a response indicating no opposition to full relief from costs as to the disciplinary matters but noting that the court has no jurisdiction regarding the Client Security Fund assessment.

Good cause appearing, the court GRANTS the motion as to the disciplinary matters. Accordingly, Leon Jacob Atlas is relieved in full from payment of costs awarded in case nos. 93-O-11396; 95-O-14720 (Cons.) (S058318); 96-PM-01675 (S046886); and 97-N-13461 (S068100). The court further ORDERS that a copy of this order be placed in each of these files.




