RESPONDENT, HENRY M. GUY ROLLINS, ("RESPONDENT") was admitted to the practice of law in the State of California on September 8, 1975, was a member at all times pertinent to these charges, and is currently a member of the State Bar of California.

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1 It is alleged that RESPONDENT wilfully committed the
2 following violations:

3 GENERAL BACKGROUND ALLEGATIONS

4 1. From on or about March 18, 1983 to on or about May 3,
5 1984, Respondent represented Jerard E. Tanner ("Tanner") in a
6 wrongful termination action against The New Yorker Magazine
7 (United States District Court, Northern District of California,
8 case no. C 824608 SAW).

9 2. From on or about May 3, 1984 to on or about October 4,
10 1994, the facts and circumstances surrounding Respondent's
11 withdrawal as Tanner's attorney have been the subject of
12 litigation between Respondent and Tanner in Marin County Superior
13 Court (Rollins v. Tanner, case no. 120690), the Court of Appeal,
14 First Appellate District, Division Two (case no. A038358 and case
15 no. A048019) and Los Angeles County Superior Court (Tanner v.
16 Rollins, case no. GC007123).

17 COUNT ONE

18 Case No. 94-O-11963

19 Business and Professions Code, section 6106
[Commission of acts involving moral turpitude and dishonesty]

20 1. On or about May 5, 1992, Tanner filed an action
21 against Respondent for Respondent's malicious prosecution of
22 Marin County Superior Court case no. 120690. Tanner's malicious
23 prosecution complaint was filed in Los Angeles County Superior
24 Court, case no. GC007123.

25 2. On or about October 27, 1992, Respondent filed a cross-
26 complaint against Tanner in case no. GC007123, seeking 25% of
27 Tanner's inheritance. Respondent's claim was based upon an
28 alleged written contract between Respondent and Tanner.
