This stipulation is made pursuant to rule 951(c), California Rules of Court, and rules 22 550, et seq., Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California. This stipulation is based upon 23 the facts set forth in Respondent's Motion for Modification of Terms and Conditions of 24 25 Probation and for an Extension of Time to Pay for Ordered Restitution. 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## **STIPULATION**

- 1. On July 26, 2001, the Supreme Court filed an Order Approving Stipulation in State Bar Court case nos. 96-O-02896; 96-O-02897; 96-O-04513; 96-O-04580; 96-O-6314; 96-O-08416; 97-O-10248; 97-O-11270; 97-O-13160; 97-O-13782; 97-O-13923; 97-O-14505; 97-O-16780, which placed Joseph Walch ("Respondent") on 5 years suspension and until he complied with Standard 1.4(c)(ii), stayed, and that he be placed on probation for 5 years on condition that he be actually suspended for 18 months and until he complied with Standard 1.4(c)(ii). Respondent was further ordered to comply with other conditions of probation, including restitution.
  - 2. The parties stipulate to extend the probation period to August 25, 2010.
- 3. The parties stipulate to extend time for Respondent to make restitution to July 2010.
- 4. All other terms and conditions attached to the probation shall remain in full force and effect.
