ORDER MODIFYING TERMS OF PROBATION AND EXTENDING TIME FOR PAYMENT OF COSTS

On April 12, 2012, respondent Danny Robert Taylor filed a motion to extend the time within which he could pay costs based on his financial hardship in case nos. 99-O-12424; 10-O-07402; and 02-O-13978 et al. On April 17, 2012, the Office of Probation of the State Bar California, by Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade, filed opposition to the motion as to the restitution owed in case no. 02-O-12978 et al. and requested that the court take notice that respondent erroneously considered his restitution condition in case no. 02-O-12978 as costs.

On April 25, 2012, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California, by Acting Assistant Chief Trial Counsel Charles A. Murray, filed opposition to the motion as to the extension of time to pay costs in case nos. 99-O-12424; 10-O-07402; and 02-O-13978 et al.

The court has considered the papers filed in this matter. GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, the motion is GRANTED. The court makes the following orders:

 Restitution payments in case nos. 02-O-13978 and 10-O-07402 are ordered to commence on August 1, 2012, at the rate of \$50 per month and increase to \$100 per month on February 1, 2013;



- The disciplinary costs imposed in case nos. 99-O-12424; 10-O-07402; and 02-O-13978 et al., shall all be due and payable on February 1, 2013;
- Respondent must provide satisfactory proof of payment of restitution to the Office of Probation with each quarterly probation report; and
- 4. Respondent must make any necessary final payment in order to complete the payment of restitution in full, including interest, no later than 30 days prior to the expiration of the period of probation.
