On April 27, 2007, the Order Approving Stipulation re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition (stipulation) was filed in the above-captioned matter. On May 7, 2007, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar (State Bar) filed a "Motion to Clarify (or Correct) Stipulation and Order of Stayed Suspension, signed April 27, 2007" (modification motion). In its modification motion, the State Bar requested that the stipulation be corrected at page 5(a), paragraph "b" to include the number of hours of Minimum Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) courses in law office management, attorney client relations and/or general legal ethics which respondent must complete as a condition of his probation.

Respondent did not file an opposition to the State Bar's modification motion.

Good cause appearing, the State Bar's Motion is **GRANTED** and the court **ORDERS** that the stipulation filed on April 27, 2007, be **MODIFIED** as follows:

On page 5(a) of the stipulation, in paragraph b, the word "six" is inserted following the words "no less than" and prior to the words "hours of Minimum Continuing Legal Education. . . ."

In addition, on the court's own motion, the stipulation filed on April 27, 2007, is hereby **MODIFIED** as follows:

On page 5 of the stipulation, section E(9), an "x" is inserted in the box next to "(9)" and

preceding the words, "The following conditions are attached hereto and incorporated."

As the State Bar did not file a response or opposition to the State Bar's modification motion and as the modification ordered pursuant to the court's own motion is clerical in nature, the matter will be transmitted to the Supreme Court without further delay.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
