



**GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR**, the opposed<sup>1</sup> request to modify respondent's terms and conditions of probation is **GRANTED, IN PART**. Respondent must commence making payments in the month of January 2011, and continue through June 2011, in the amount of \$300 per month, instead of the current \$1000 per month. Commencing in July 2011, the amount of the payment will return to \$1,000 per month. Except as set forth in this order, all other conditions and obligations of probation will remain the same.

Further, **GOOD CAUSE ALSO APPEARING THEREFOR**, the opposed request for relief from or extension of time to pay discipline costs is **GRANTED, IN PART**. Respondent must pay all presently outstanding discipline costs in three equal installments, to be billed and payable along with the dues payable to the State Bar of California for the years 2011, 2012 and 2013.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


