Respondent's opposed motion to modify restitution seeks to allow respondent to make payment to the Client Security Fund instead of directly to the former clients to whom the restitution is owed. Respondent asserts that this modification is necessary because he is unable to pay the balance of the restitution owed to Saul and Lucero Viramontes (\$35.00) and Shirle Jones (\$583.40) due to the fact that they either refuse to cash the payment or refuse to answer the door when respondent attempts to deliver payment.

**GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR**, the motion is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. respondent must first file with this court a declaration setting forth the efforts made to contact the above individuals;
2. respondent must send, by certified or registered mail to their last known address, a letter informing them of the fact that he will make payment directly to the Client Security Fund and that they may make claim to money held in that fund; and



3. respondent must provide proof satisfactory to the Office of Probation that he has sent the letter described above, and that he has made the deposit to the Client Security Fund.

Respondent must make all payments by December 20, 2010, provided that he may make the \$583.40 payment in two payments of \$291.70 by December 20, 2010 and the balance by January 15, 2011.


